- WHEREAS, rigorous scientific research and years of "hands-on" experience demonstrate that crime can be greatly reduced by providing quality violence and crime prevention education in early education and child care programs for all families, after-school programs, and community policing interventions designed to improve parenting and prevent child abuse and neglect as well as to prevent predatory violence from abduction, sexual assault, molestation and bullying in schools;
- **WHEREAS**, investments in this Nation's communities personal safety education reduces crime and increases opportunity for self realization and personal empowerment in not only children's lives but for all Americans;
